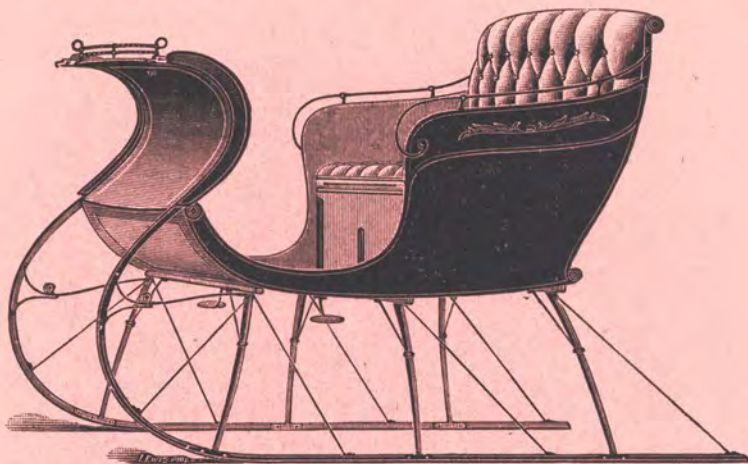

Jolly Corks" with Charles Vivian at their head; but now the leaven of a new and powerful sentiment was working among them, inciting them to better things. Their organization was effected and fundamental laws enacted, their officers elected, a permanent abiding place selected and their charter secured from the state of New York. Philadelphia came next. Then the Elk, at a bound, o'er leaped the continent, and San Francisco became a sister lodge; Chicago next; then Cincinnati. Rochester came in as number 24. The last decade has witnessed a phenomenal growth in the vast herding of the Elks. A chain of lodges encircles the union, and the tap of the gavel is heard in every state and territory of the nation. The branching antlers of the Elks, 50,000 strong, are sported in 397 lodge rooms, many of them furnished with rare taste and magnificence.

We can imagine the tales that were told, the wondrous legends recited, the songs that were sung, the eleven o'clock toast quaffed in good old English stout! We can fancy Shakespeare, the ruler of that mighty herd, reading to a mighty

When ye master hath returned from these assemblages, he appeareth warmed with wine and is quite full of wondrous wit, and talks much of the poesy of the player, one William Shakespeare, who is the mighty ruler of this herd of Elks." 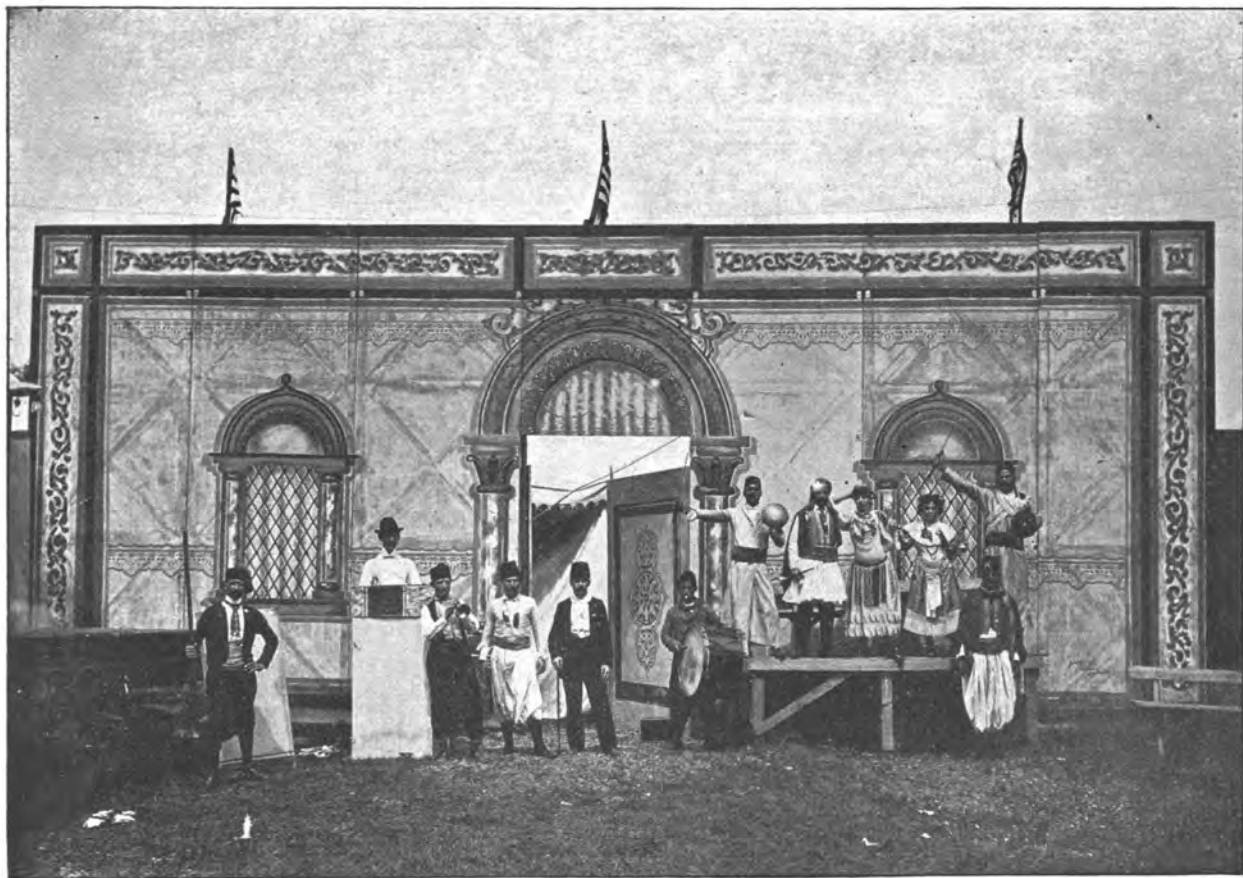

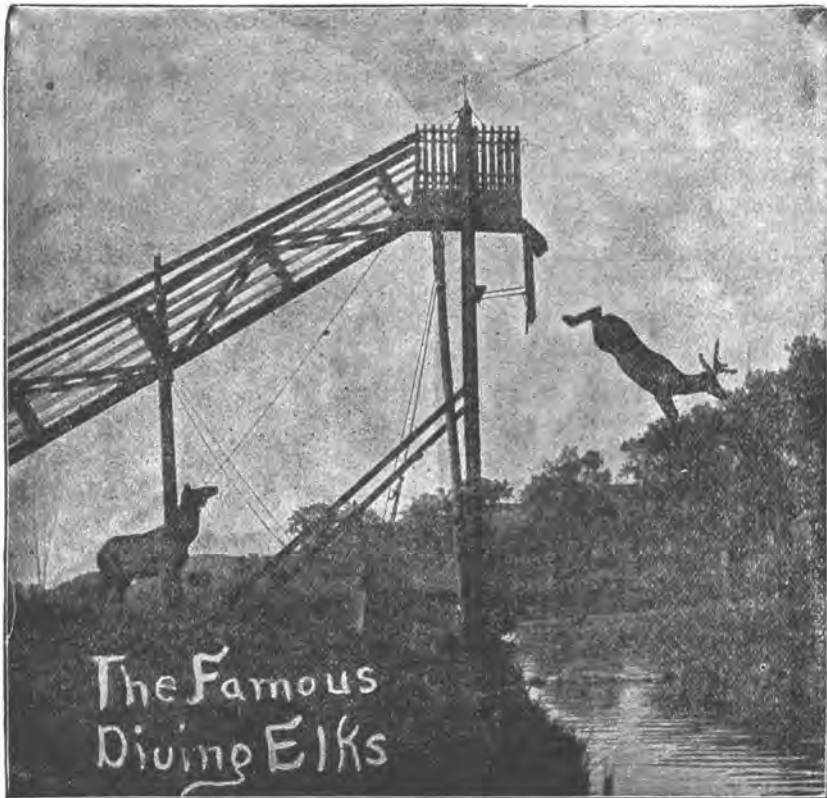
