## PLACES to SEE . . . THINGS to DO . . .

### GENESEE REGION

The Thruway crosses the picturesque Genesee River north of the deep rock cut Genesee Gorge, the "Grand Canyon of the East." Interchanges 45 and 46 provide convenient access north of Rochester, New York's third largest city, famed as a photographic and cultural center, and southerly toward Letchworth State Park, Rochester's many attractions include Highland Park, world-famed for its spectacular lilac display in May, Memorial Art Gallery and Museum of Arts and Sciences and famous Kodak Park.

### NIAGARA FRONTIER

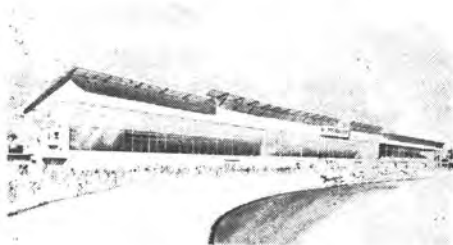
