## COVERING THE TV BEAT:

**GOOD FORMULA:** The popularity of FIRESIDE THEATER, can be traced to Frank Wisbar, producer-director, whose most important job, he says, is the careful selection of material. Wisbar explains that Fireside dramas are not necessarily "arty." They are aimed towards the general public but, says the director, "Ours is not a formula show. It does not follow a set prescription." There, in a few words, you have the secret to one of the most popular telefilm series on the air.....

**NEW SOURCES NEEDED FOR TV:** Television producers are looking over the major magazines as sources for video material. A deal is cooking to film stories used in Cosmopolitan and the Reader's Digest material is already going before the cameras .....And, a new source of summer entertainment will be the replacement show of THE GOLDBERGS when DENNIS DAY goes off for the season.....

**HUSBAND & WIFE:** Recently pretty Patti Palmer, wife of comedian JERRY LEWIS, debuted on the COMEDY HOUR. She sings, and very well, too - and now she and Jerry are making some terrific Capitol records together.....

**TRUMAN RUMORS:** The rumors are flying again that former President Truman will star in a video series. We doubt them because Mr. Truman has just been signed by Doubleday to complete his memoirs for publication in 1955. This will keep the ex-President mighty busy between now and then.....

**NO VACATIONS:** The Sunday clown prince of comedy, RED SKELTON, isn't going to rest after all this summer. It looks now as if the Redhead will do some personal appearances across the nation - playing to some of the audiences he's entertained all winter long. His health has improved so that the doctors have given the green light for such a tour.....WALLY COX, or Mr. Peepers, if you prefer, will get little rest on his "vacation"...The delightful ocomedian has been signed to play the lead in the strawhat version of the famous Broadway hit "Three Men On A Horse".....

**HE STARTED SINGING:** Lyle Sudrow, who plays Bill Bauer in the "GUIDING LIGHT", started out as a singler and joined the Shuberts to sing baritone roles in operettas. Just as he was warming up to his new success, the induction into the Coast Guards got him, and he spent three years in Uncle Sam's service during World War II.....

STAR-LITE: The title, "Comedy Find of the Year," honorarily tagged on RED BUTTONS by critics and viewers alike since the "Ho-Ho" comic made his TV debut last October, is definitely confirmed by the increased station line-up and current rating of his "RED BUTTONS SHOW." Buttons, talented young Broadway and night club comic whose hilarious monologues and sketches have established him as a solid TV favorite in the short span of six months, is now seen weekly over 90 stations and has a "Top Ten" rating of 45.1, according to the latest reports....

BIG DOINGS: This is a b-i-g p-r-o-d-u-c-t-i-o-n! KUKLA, FRAN and OLLIE will appear with the Boston Pops Orchestra on Sunday, June 7, in an original operetta based on the famous legend, "St. George and the Dragon.".....

CHATTER: Lovely MARIA RIVA and WILLIAM RIVA will co-star in a television series to be filmed in Israel, Turkey and Egypt.....MARY MARGARET McBRIDE has started her 20th consecutive year in radio and still shuns television..... GALE STORM, whose popularity has soared due only in part to her acting ability on "My Little Margie," will be paid a cool \$10,000 per week for a night club date in Las Vegas....

ON THE LINE: How do script writers feel about having their lines crossed out for the sake of shortening a script? Ask PEG LYNCH, creator-writer and star of "Ethel and Albert" - she'll tell you it's a trying ordeal. Since every TV writer must write a little more than is required rather than a little less, television scripts must always be shortened during rehearsals. Miss Lynch admits that she, herself, never can decide on which lines to cut and which lines to keep, therefore always respects the judgement of director Walter Hart on this score. "When I see a line get cut out, it's just as if someone had just operated on me".....

FROM REEL TO REAL: Handsome GEORGE REEVES, who has become a national hero to millions of youngsters for his portrayal of SUPERMAN on television, was signed by Columbia Pictures to play the roll of Sgt. Stark in "From Here to Eternity." He had to get a G.I. haircut for the part, and now WHIT ELLWORTH, the producer of the Superman film series, is waiting patiently for his hair to grow back...Production will be held up about a month while the Reeves' locks are sprouting.....

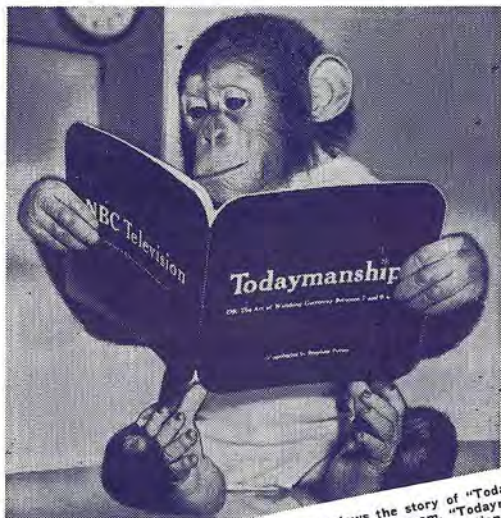

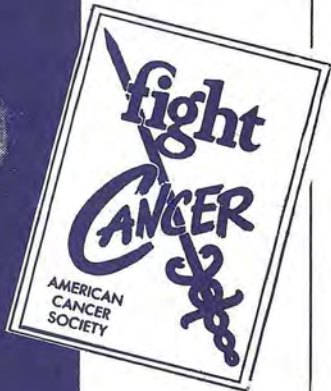
